

Gaming Mouse vs Regular Mouse (vsdiff.com)

Feature	Gaming Mouse	Regular Mouse
DPI (Dots Per Inch)	Typically ranges from 400 to over 16,000 DPI, allowing for precise movements.	Average DPI around 800 to 1600, which is suitable for general tasks.
