Feature	Smart Home	Traditional Home
Definition	<i>A home equipped with devices that automate tasks and improve efficiency.</i>	<i>A conventional home with standard appliances and systems.</i>
Control	<b>Remote and centralized control through apps and devices.</b>	<b>Manual control; reliance on physical devices.</b>
Energy Efficiency	<b>Significantly higher, due to automated energy management.</b>	<b>Generally lower; energy use is less optimized.</b>
Initial Cost	<b>Higher upfront investment for technology integration.</b>	<b>Usually lower initial cost.</b>
Security	<b>Enhanced security features: smart cameras, locks, and alarms.</b>	<b>Standard security measures, usually requiring manual checks.</b>
Maintenance	<b>Requires technical knowledge; potential software issues.</b>	<b>Easier to maintain, less reliance on tech.</b>
Customization	<b>Highly customizable; ability to integrate various technologies.</b>	<b>Limited customization options.</b>
