Criteria	Soft Skills	Hard Skills
Definition	Personal attributes that enable interactions with others.	Technical abilities and knowledge needed to perform specific tasks.
Examples	Communication, teamwork, adaptability, problem-solving.	Programming, data analysis, accounting, project management.
Measurement	Typically assessed through behavior and performance.	Usually evaluated via tests, certifications, or tangible outcomes.
Application	Useful in interpersonal interactions and team dynamics.	Essential for job-specific responsibilities and tasks.
Development	Can be improved through practice, feedback and experience.	Often learned through formal education and training.
Relevance in the Job Market	Gaining importance as companies prioritize teamwork and collaboration.	Crucial for entry-level positions requiring specific knowledge.
