

Work Permit vs Green Card (vsdiff.com)

Criteria	Work Permit	Green Card
Definition	Temporary authorization to work in a foreign country.	Permanent residency status allowing indefinite stay.
Duration	Usually limited to a specific period (e.g., 1-3 years).	Indefinite until revoked or renounced.
Eligibility	Varies by country and type of work; often requires a job offer.	Eligible after sponsorship, family relationship, or employment.
Work Flexibility	Usually tied to a specific employer.	More freedom to change jobs and employers.
Path to Citizenship	Generally does not provide a pathway to citizenship.	Can lead to citizenship after meeting specific criteria.
