Decision-Making	Often driven by gut feeling and innovation.	Based on data and established protocols.
Objective	Maximize growth and market share.	Minimize potential losses and secure data.
Investment	Requires significant initial capital with uncertain returns.	Focuses on continuous investment in security technologies.
