

Laser Printer vs Inkjet Printer (vsdiff.com)

Feature	Laser Printer	Inkjet Printer
Print Quality	High-quality text and sharp lines.	Excellent color prints, but less sharp text.
Print Speed	Faster printing speeds (typically 20-100 pages per minute).	Slower speeds (typically 5-15 pages per minute).
Cost Per Page	Lower cost per page, especially for large volume printing.	Higher cost per page, particularly for color prints.
Initial Cost	Higher upfront cost.	Lower upfront cost.
Maintenance	Less frequent maintenance; toner lasts longer.	More frequent maintenance; ink cartridges need regular replacement.
Best For	High-volume printing, text documents, small businesses.	Home use, photo printing, small documents.
