Criteria	Strategic Thinking	Tactical Execution
<b>Definition</b>	Long-term planning that focuses on overarching goals and the broader vision.	Short-term actions and plans aimed at achieving specific objectives.
<b>Time Horizon</b>	Future-oriented (months to years)	Present-oriented (days to months)
<b>Focus Area</b>	Big picture analysis and concept formulation.	Implementation of specific tasks and operational details.
<b>Decision-Making</b>	Involves high-level decisions that shape direction.	Involves day-to-day decision-making and immediate problem-solving.
<b>Examples</b>	Market expansion plans, product development strategy.	Daily team meetings, task prioritization.
<b>Skills Required</b>	Analytical thinking, foresight, creativity.	Organizational skills, attention to detail, adaptability.
<b>Outcome Measurement</b>	Success is measured by overall business growth and adaptability.	Success is measured by immediate results and efficiency.
