

## Temporary Staff vs Permanent Staff (vsdiff.com)

Feature	Temporary Staff	Permanent Staff
<b>Employment Duration</b>	Short-term, often project-based	Long-term, ongoing employment
<b>Commitment</b>	Limited commitment to the employer	High commitment level from both sides
<b>Training and Development</b>	Usually less training provided	More investment in training and career development
<b>Cost to Employer</b>	Potentially lower in short term	Higher due to benefits and long-term salary
<b>Flexibility</b>	Highly flexible; can scale staff up or down easily	Less flexible; more stable but harder to adjust
<b>Company Culture Fit</b>	May not fully integrate into the company culture	More likely to align with company values and culture
