Current Status	Can still be found in the wild	No living individuals
Conservation Efforts	Active programs for protection	Extinct species cannot be conserved
Research Opportunities	Extensive research ongoing	Limited to <i>fossils</i> and historical data
Examples	Amur Leopard, Vaquita	Woolly Mammoth, Dodo
