

## Vertebrate vs Invertebrate (vsdiff.com)

Features	Vertebrates	Invertebrates
Definition	Animals with a backbone.	Animals without a backbone.
Examples	Mammals, Birds, Fish, Reptiles, Amphibians.	Insects, Arachnids, Mollusks, Crustaceans.
Body Structure	Complex body structure with skeletal systems.	Simpler body forms, diverse shapes without skeletons.
Reproduction	Mostly internal reproduction; some external (fish).	Varied reproductive strategies, often external.
Nervous System	More complex nervous systems; centralized brain.	Generally simpler; ganglia in many.
Habitat	Land, air, and water environments.	Predominantly terrestrial and aquatic; some extreme habitats.
